locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress,

approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations, CLAIMS

12,000 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the PLATINUM
MOAU 238 TIN TITANIUM CU CR MG FL & HG,
lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips,

angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 12,000 feet ON EACH

side and 12,000 feet on the NORTH TO SOUTH side of the middle
of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,

lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim IS 6,000 feet

running NORTH from center of discovery SOUTH, and 6,000

feet running SOUTH from center of discovery NORTH; said discovery

IS being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines

of said claim, in T4N R5E Mining District, PINCHOT NATIONAL FOREST

THE ABOVE CLAIM IS described by metes and
bounds as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at Cor. No. 1 (the NE COR corner), running thence 12,000
feet WEST, to a post marked NW COR; thence 12,000
feet SOUTH, to a post marked SW corner (Cor. No. 2); thence 12,000
feet EAST, to a post marked SE corner (Cor. No. 3); thence 12,000
feet NORTH, to a post marked NE COR; thence 12,000 feet
to a post marked corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 12,000 feet
to a post marked corner, the place beginning.

This claim is further described as follows: The point of discovery upon which this notice is
posted is in a SOUTHERLY direction from the center of the PLATINUM end
line, distant 6,000 feet. From Cor. No. 1 THIS CLAIM
