

STATEMENT OF ANNUAL LABOR FOR THE YEAR
ENDING AUGUST 31, 1977

Useful work and improvements in the amount of more than \$24,100.00 were done and made during the period from September 1, 1976 to May 1, 1977 by Longyear Company, E. 5311 Railroad Avenue, Spokane, Washington 99221, at the request of AMOCO Minerals Company, whose address is 333 West Hampden, Englewood, Colorado 80110 for all of the lode mining claims listed in attached "Exhibit A", located in the Copper Creek mining district, Skamania County, Washington, T.3 N, R.5 E., W.M., in Sections 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 10; and T.4 N., R.5 E., W.M. in Sections 27, 28, 29, 32, 33 and 34.

A total of 241 contiguous mining claims are included in this statement. Work and improvements required more than 292 man-days of labor, consisting of 6,750.50 feet of diamond core drilling completed in eleven holes, as follows:
