September 1977, located and claimed, and by these presents do locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress,

approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations, claim

1500 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the surface

lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips,

angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 1500 feet
