Notice of Mining Location

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a vein or lode of mineral bearing rock in place upon the unappropriated public domain of the United States within the State of ~~Ore~~ and said Mining District; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States, of the State of ~~Ore~~ and the regulations of said Mining District, have located and do hereby locate a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post at the point of discovery, marked Post No. 1. The name of the claims ^{are} The Alpha #1 and #2. Claim, further described as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1 (Discovery Post), from thence
 20' feet in a Southeasterly direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence
 300' feet in a Northeasterly direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence
 1,500' feet in a 50° Northeasterly direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence
 300' feet in a Southwesterly direction to an end post marked No. 5, thence
 300' feet in a Southwesterly direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence
 1,500' feet in a 50° Southeasterly direction to a corner post marked No. 7, thence
 300' feet in a Northeasterly direction to said end post marked No. 2.
 The locators claim 1,480 feet in a Northwesterly direction from point of discovery to the North end line and 20' feet in the opposite direction from point of discovery to the South end line and 300' feet on each side of the middle of said vein or lode, further claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as being 1,200 feet from a natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity, to-wit: Slide Creek Bridge (use township and range, if possible)
 Sec. 17 & extending into Sec. 18 T4N. R5E. WM--#2 claim Joins The Alpha #1 on the West. The Alpha #2 claim being 600' by 1,500'. The southern border of both Alpha #1 and Alpha #2 begin at the center of the East Fork of the Lewis River.

The general course or strike of the vein or lode as nearly as may be determined is Northwesterly with reference to the natural object or permanent monument described above. The adjoining claims are Richardson Lode--on the East.

This notice is placed at discovery post No. 1; posts are placed at each corner and both center ends, and the name of this vein or lode and date of location are placed on all posts so that the boundaries of the claim may be readily traced. In construing this location notice, the singular includes the plural and vice versa, where the context so requires.
