3. The above-described lode mining claims are held and claimed by said undersigned owner thereof for the valuable mineral contained therein.

4. Said undersigned owner of the above-described lode mining claims intends to continue diligent exploration and/or development of such lode mining claims.

5. Said undersigned owner of the above-described lode mining claims has located said lode mining claims in accordance with Federal, State, County, and Municipal laws and regulations, and pursuant to such laws and regulations, said undersigned owner of the above-described lode mining claims shall file, in the proper BLM office, prior to the 31st day of December, 1977, evidence of annual assessment work performed on the above-described lode mining claims during the preceeding assessment year or a notice of intention to hold such mining claims. Consequently, this Notice of Intention to Hold Mining Claims is for the purpose of compliance with such laws and regulations in regard to the fact:

a. That labor and improvements in the sum and value of more than \$900.00 consisting of drilling to a depth of approximately 100 feet between the five day period extending from the 17th to the 22nd days of June, 1977, were performed or made as assessment work on the above-described lode mining claims or on mining claims contiguous thereto by or on behalf of the undersigned owner thereof during such preceeding assessment year ending the 1st day of September, 1977.

b. That evidence of such assessment work was not filed in the office of the local jurisdiction of the State in which the above-described lode mining claims are located.

c. That the impediment, beyond the control of said undersigned owner of the above-described lode mining claims, that prevented the filing, in the office of the local jurisdiction of the State in which said lode mining claims are lo-
