

cated, of an affidavit of assessment work performed evidencing such assessment work is that such laws and regulations provide (i) that in order to hold the possessory right to the above-described lode mining claims, labor must be performed or improvements made as assessment work thereon annually in the period commencing at 12 o'clock meridian on the 1st day of September, 1977; and (ii) that evidence of such assessment work performed or made during such period of time fixed for assessment work need only be filed in said office of local jurisdiction within thirty (30) days after the expiration of such period of time fixed for assessment work, and as of the 31st day of December, 1977, such period of time fixed for assessment work for the above-described lode mining claims will not yet have expired.

6. The date on which this Notice of Intention to Hold Mining Claims was filed in the office of the local jurisdiction in which the above-described lode mining claims are located is that date entered hereon by such office of local jurisdiction.
