### Didier to Jarvis

This Indenture Made this 21st day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nine between Joseph H.Didier and Ida Didier husband and wife at the time deed was issued to Joseph H.Didier by H.P.Davis and wife, the parties of the first part and Joseph G.Jarvis of Hood River, Oregon, the party of the second part, witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred (100) dollars gold coin of the United States to then in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said first parties do by these presents grant, bargain, sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns the following described tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington and particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of section six (6) in Township one (1) North of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, running thence north along the east side line of said southwest quarter sixteen (16) rods and ten (10) feet, being along the County Road, thence northwesterly along County Road eighty three (83) rods to a point at which the lately private road known as "Marrin & Didier Road, now a County Road, intersects the said County Road; thence Southwesterly and following said private road, now County Road, to thirty-six (36) rods to a point on the south line of said section six (6) which point is one hundred and one (101) rods and six (6) feet west of the southeast corner of said southwest quarter of section six (6), thence East along the south line of said section six one hundred and one (101) rods and six feet to point of beginning, containing twelve and seven eighths ( $12\frac{7}{8}$ ) acres more or less. Above mentioned private road is now made a County road forty feet wide and the land for such road through this piece of land has been dedicated for this purpose and is not conveyed by this deed of warranty. Together with the appurtenances to have and to hold the said premises with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part, their heirs executors and administrators do by these presents covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, that they are the owners in fee simple of the above granted premises and that the same are free from all incumbrances whatsoever and the above grantors do covenant and agree that they shall and will warrant and defend.
