

STATEMENT OF ANNUAL LABOR FOR THE YEAR  
ENDING AUGUST 31, 1978

Useful work and improvements in the amount of more than \$20,500.00 were done and made during the period from September 1, 1977 to August 31, 1978, by Longyear Company, E. 5311 Railroad Avenue, Spokane, Washington 99221 and Lee G. Gribner, Box 75, Trout Lake, Washington 98650, at the request of AMOCO Minerals Company, whose address is 333 West Hampden, Englewood, Colorado 80110 for all of the lode mining claims listed in attached "Exhibit A", located in the Copper Creek mining district, Skamania County, Washington, T.3 N., R.5 E., W.M., in Sections 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 10; and T.4 N., R.5 E., W.M. in Sections 27, 28, 29, 32, 33 and 34.

A total of 205 contiguous mining claims are included in this statement. Work and improvements required more than 24 man-days of labor, consisting of 1,000 feet of diamond core drilling completed in two holes as follows:
