

S.F.P.Rd.Co. to Wind River L.Co.

This Indenture made this 28th day of March A.D.1911 between the Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company a corporation duly incorporated under an act of Congress Approved March 3,1897, by Clark W. Thompson its attorney in fact, and the Wind River Lumber Company a corporation under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, Witnesseth:

Whereas said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company being heretofore the owner of Lot numbered five of Section one Township nineteen north Range six East of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, in Arizona, situated and included within the limits of the San Francisco Mountains Forest Reserve, and Whereas said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad company has under the provisions of the act of Congress approved June 4th 1897 entitled an act making appropriations for sundry civil expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth 1898 and for other purposes, reconveyed and relinquished the said tract of land to the United States and has, under the provisions of said act, selected in lieu thereof all of Lot three section seven Township three North of Range eight East of Willamette Meridian, in Skamania county Washington, containing 38.20 acres:

Now therefore, Know all men by these presents that said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad company by Clark W. Thompson its attorney in fact, in consideration of ten dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable considerations to it in hand paid by said Wind River Lumber Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has by this quitclaim deed bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain, sell and convey unto said Wind River Lumber Co. its successors and assigns all of the right title and interest that it now has or may hereafter acquire in and to all of the following described real property situate lying and being in Skamania county state of Washington to-wit:

All of Lot three of Section seven in Township three North of Range eight East of Willamette Meridian containing 38.20 acres. Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all its right title and interest of any kind whether at law or equity of, in or to the same and each and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the above described and granted premises unto the said Wind River Lumber Co. its successors and assigns forever.
