I, Fred Ladzik not married, of Butler County of Skamania State of Washington of the age of forty six years, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and not acting under duress menace fraud or undue influence of any person whomsoever, do make public and declare this my last will and testament in the manner and form following to-wit:

First: It is my will and I do order that all my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be done after my deceased.

Second I give, bequeath and devise to Rudolph H. Koch, aged about 32 years, residing at Butler Skamania County State of Washington all of my estate whether real personal or mixed property of every name and nature whatsoever and wherever situated, owned by me at the time of my death/together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the same unto said Rudolph H. Koch his heirs and assigns forever. Lastly I hereby nominate constitute and appoint said Rudolph H. Koch to be the executor of this my last will and testament and hereby direct that no bonds be required of him as such executor, hereby revoking all other wills legacies and bequests to me heretofore made, and declaring this and no other to be my last will and testament.
