This Indenture Witnesseth that Cornelius O.Hanlon and Catherine Hanlon his wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000.00) in gold coin of the United States to them in hand paid by John Modrow party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have remised, release and quitclaim and by these presents do remise release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, all merchantable timber on the following described premises situate lying and being in the County of Skamania state of Washington, to-wit:

All the merchantable timber standing or down on the following described land to-wit:

The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec.33 Tp. 2 N Range 5 East Willamette Meridian. Said second party are to remove all the timber from said described property in a period of two years from and after the date herein mentioned. All timber remaining on said property at the end of the two years reverts back to the original owner his heirs or assigns. Said first party further agree to allow said second party his heirs or assigns to log and haul any other timber across the above described land for the above mentioned time of two years; provided said second party to not trespass over any land fenced in at the present time.

To have and to hold the said premises with all their appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
