KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That E.E. Romig, of 310 Oak Street, Portland Oregon, the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of (\$160.00) One Hundred Sixty and no/100 DOLLARS, of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by Exile Burkitt the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, transferred and set over ~~xxxx~~ and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, assigns, transfer, and set over, unto the said party of the second part, a certain INDENTURE OF MORTGAGE, bearing date the 5th day of March, A.D. One Thousand Nine-Hundred and Fifteen made and executed by J.T. Alexander and Ada F. Alexander, (husband and wife,) to Gustaf Lovegren and Assigned by him in blank on May 13th, 1915, to the said party of the first part, to secure the payment of the sum of (\$750.00) Seven Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars, together with the note or obligation therein described, and the money due or to grow due thereon, with the interest; which said Indenture of Mortgage was recorded in the office of the Recorder of Conveyances of the _____ County of Skamania State of Washington in Book M of Mortgages, page 512 on the 8th day of March, A.D. 1915,

And the said party of the first part does hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second part that the said party of the first part is the lawful owner and holder of the said note and Mortgage, and that he has good right to sell, transfer and assign, the same as aforesaid, and that there is now due and owing upon said ~~right note~~ and mortgage the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars with interest from the 5th day of March, A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred fifteen.
