July, 1979, located and claimed, and by these presents do locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress, approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations,

1500 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips, angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 300 feet N side and 300 feet on the S side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins, lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 1490 feet running W from center of discovery, and 10 feet running E from center of discovery; said discovery


