Keller to Blazier Timber Co.

Know all men by these presents that George E. Keller and Maude L. Keller his wife, of Clarke County State of Washington, being of lawful age, in consideration of fifty five hundred (\$5500.00) dollars to us paid by Blazier Timber Company a corporation under the laws of the state of Oregon, do grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said Blazier Timber Company its successors and assigns all of the following described property situated in the county of Skamania state of Washington, to-wit:

All the timber now standing growing or in any wise located upon the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section seventeen (17), Township two (2) North of Range six (6) East of the W.M. together with the right and privilege of going upon the said land for the purpose of removing the said timber provided that the said timber is removed within twenty years (20) from the date hereof; together with the right and privilege of hauling any other timber over and across said described land and the right to locate upon said land any railroad or logging railroad or tramway for the purpose of removing the timber upon said land or transporting timber from other lands over and across the same. To have and to hold the same unto the grantee forever. And the grantors do covenant to and with the grantee that or are lawfully seized in fee of the above property that it is free from all incumbrances and that we will and our heirs shall warrant and defend the above granted premises to the said grantee its successors and assigns forever against all lawful claims and demands.
