Notice of Location of Placer Claim

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a placer deposit of minerals upon the unappropriated public domain of the United States within the above state, county and mining district, which minerals are subject to location under the mineral and mining laws of the United States, and have located and hereby do locate a placer claim thereon, named the *LAST CHANCE* Claim, which is described as follows:

thence *752* feet in a *North Westerly* direction to a point marked No. 4;
thence *300* feet in a *South Westerly* direction to a point marked No. 5;
thence *300* feet in a *South Westerly* direction to a point marked No. 6;
thence *752* feet in a *South Easterly* direction to a point marked No. 7;
thence *300* feet in a *North Easterly* direction to the place of beginning.
