Tunnel Site Location Skamania County

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned does claim a tunnel site known as Firhook III. This claim shall begin at corner Post #3 of the Firhook I Lode Claim thence 3000 ft upstream Boulder Creek in a Northerly direction including all veins uncovered within said 3000 ft length and a length of 1500 ft for each vein.

This notice has been placed at corner post number 3 on Firhook I Lode Claim (A 14-inch white fir tree 50 ft west of Boulder Creek). Another post has been placed 3000 ft upstream Boulder Creek to indicate the Northern limit of the Claim.

The claim is further described as follows: on national forest land (Gifford Pinchot National Forest), in Boulder Creek tributary of the Lewis River approximately one mile upstream from Forest Service Road N-90. Site is in Washington, Skamania County. The land is unsurveyed, but land description projections indicate Section 43, Township 9N, Range 9E, W.M.
