BUTLER TO ATTWELL.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 23rd day of March, 1916, between William Butler and Sarah Butler, husband and wife parties of the first part, and Myrtle Attwell party of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of TWO THOUSAND (\$2000.00) Dollars, LAWFUL MONEY OF THE UNITED STATES, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Warrant unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns, the following described tracts and parcels of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Part of Lot 4 of Section 35 Twp. 2 N. of R. 6 E. bounded as follows: Commencing at the quarter post between sections 34 and S. 35, thence south on a true line 10 chains and 50 links to the right bank of the Columbia River, thence up along by the meanders of said River N 65 deg. C 5 chains and 64 links, thence North 40 deg. c1 chain and 76 links, thence North 34 deg. C 4 chains and 75 links, thence north 4 deg. C 2 chains and 48 links, thence North 37 deg. C 4 chains and 35 links to the bank of Duncan Slough N 85 deg. W 89 links, thence S 58 deg. W 10 chains and 55 links, thence N 36 deg. W 2 chains & 96 links to the place of beginning, containing 10 acres and 31/100 acres, more or less.

Also all shore land situated south and in front of Lot Four (4) of Section 35 as far East as the outlet of Duncan Lake, in Township two (2) North, of Range Six (6) East Willamette Meridian, containing three (3) acres more or less.

Also all that part of the southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section thirty four in Township two (2) North of Range six (6) East of W.M., that lies south of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Right of way, said piece of land containing one and one half acres, more or less.

Also lot one (1) Section thirty four (34), Township two (2) North, Range six (6) East of Willamette Meridian, containing 39 acres more or less, according to the Government Survey thereof, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

Saving and excepting therefrom and subject to all rights of way and easements which may have been or has heretofore been granted over and across or in any way affecting any of the above described pieces or real estate.

THIS CONVEYANCE is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States, together with interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent per annum from date until paid, according to the terms and conditions of a certain promissory note, bearing date March 23rd, 1916, made by William Butler and
