

Thun to Barnes

This Indenture Made this 28th day of February 1911 between Louis Thun and Emilie Thun husband and wife of Underwood Washington, the parties of the first part, and Orange P. Barnes, party of the second part witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand (\$1000.00) dollars legal money of the United States to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns the following described tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington and bounded and described as follows to-wit:

All of the Northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of section nine (9) Township three (3) North of Range ten (10) East of Willamette meridian containing ^{except the timber on said tract} ten (10) acres more or less, Together with the appurtenances to have and to hold the said premises with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part, their heirs executors and administrators do by these presents covenant grant and agree to and with the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, that they the said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns, all and singular the premises hereinabove conveyed, with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, and against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, shall and will Warrant and Defend.
