Kribs of Portland Oregon, party of the second part, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns the following described real property situate and lying in the County of Skamania state of Washington to-wit:

All that portion of the Felix G. Iman Donation land Claim Number 44 in sections two (2) and eleven (11) in Township two (2) North of Range seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian which lies north of the right of way of the Spokane Portland and Seattle Railroad, except the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said section two heretofore deeded to Frank Morrison and J. Graves under bonds for deeds recorded on pages 24 and 181 of Book K of deeds of the records of the recorder of Skamania County Washington, containing two hundred and seventy five acres more or less.
