Wigal to Home Valley Irrigation & Power Co.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, E.J. Wigal, for and in consideration of a free flow of water through a two inch pipe, placed (4) four inches from the bottom of the floor, for garden, lawn and domestic use to him in hand paid by the Home Valley Irrigation & Power Company, a corporation incorporated and organized under the laws of the State of Washington, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Home Valley Irrigation & Power Company, its successors and assigns, a perpetual right of way sixty (60) feet in width, for a ditch and flume over and along that certain parcel of real property, the center line of which said strip is described as follows, -- being thirty (30) feet in width on each side of said line-to-wit: Commencing at a point which is due west of the Northeast corner of Lot 6, Section 36, Township 4 North, Range 7½ East, W.M., 793.7 feet; thence south 28° 18' west, 111.1 feet; thence to the right along a 60° curve, 89.2 feet; thence to the left along a 100° curve 100.3 feet; thence south 18° 27' east, 27.2 feet; thence to the right along a 20° curve 59.3 feet; thence south 6° 35' east, 138.3 feet; thence to the right along 20° curve, 188.1 feet; thence south 31° 02' west, 6.7 feet; thence to the left along a 20° curve, 240 feet; thence south 16° 58' east, 1008.9 feet; thence to the right along an 8° curve, 220.9 feet; thence south 0° 42' west, 598.0 feet to a point from which the southeast corner of Lot 7 of said Section 36 bears due east 684.5 feet. SO HAVE AND TO HOLD said right of way unto said Home Valley Irrigation & Power Company, its successors and assigns forever for its uses and for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, operating, repairing and reconstructing a ditch and flume for the purpose of irrigation and for transporting lumber and other freight, together with the right and privilege of entering upon said parcel of real property with men, teams and instruments and appliances necessary and convenient for use in constructing, repairing, maintaining, operating, repairing, and reconstructing
