The State of Washington does hereby bargain, sell grant and convey unto Joseph Paquet, his heirs and assigns the following described shore land of the second class situate in Skamania county Washington to-wit:

All shore lands of the second class owned by the state of Washington situate in front of adjacent to or abutting upon that portion of the government meander line described as follows:

Beginning at the meander corner of fractional sections 30 and 31 Township 2 North of Range 7 east of the willamette meridian thence in front of section 31 as follows: South 46 15' West 3 chains south 69 west 5 chains; west 5.19 chains, having a total frontage along said meander line of 13.19 chains.

To have and to hold the said premises with all their appurtenances unto the said Joseph Paquet his heirs and assigns forever.
