Lincoln to Lennan Land Co.

This Indenture made this 16th day of December 1910 between Isaac Lincoln and Margaret Lincoln husband and wife, parties of the first part and Lennan Land company a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of South Dakota, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of one dollar and other considerations to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part and to its successors and assigns forever, all the tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Skamania state of Washington and described as follows to-wit:

The southeast quarter of section thirty-three (33) in Township three (3) North of Range six (6) East of W.M.; and the west half of the southwest quarter, the southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter and Lot four (4) of section three (3) in Township two (2) North of Range six (6) East of Willamette Meridian, all containing 320 acres more or less according to government survey thereof to have and to hold the same together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to the said party of the second part and to its successors and assigns forever. And the said Isaac Lincoln and Margaret Lincoln, parties of the first part for themselves and for their heirs, executors and administrators do covenant to and with the said party of the second part its successors and assigns that they are well seized in fee of the land and premises aforesaid and have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that the same are free from all incumbrances and the above bargained and conveyed lands and premises in the quiet and peaceable possession of the party of the second part, its successors and assigns against all persons lawfully claiming or to claim to same or any part thereof the said party of the second part will warrant and defend.
