

STATEMENT OF ANNUAL LABOR FOR THE YEAR
ENDING AUGUST 31, 1979

Useful work and improvements in the amount of more than \$24,400.00 were done and made during the period from September 1, 1978 to August 31, 1979, by Longyear Company, E. 5311 Railroad Avenue, Spokane, Washington 99221 and John Cook Inc., 3807 East 11th Avenue, Spokane, Washington 99202, at the request of Denison Mines (U.S.) Incorporated, whose address is N. 9107 Country Homes Boulevard, Spokane, Washington 99218 for all of the lode mining claims listed in attached "Exhibit A", located in the Copper Creek mining district, Skamania County, Washington, T. 3 N., R. 5 E., W.M., in Sections 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 10; T. 4 N., R. 5 E., W.M., in Sections 27, 28, 29, 32, 33 and 34.

A total of 244 contiguous mining claims are included in this statement. Work and improvements required more than 30 man-days of labor, consisting of more than 2,000 feet of core drilling completed in seven holes as follows:
