Schulze to Loudon

This Indenture made this 24th day of December 1910 between William Schulze of the County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, the party of the first part, and Arthur Loudon of the same County and State party of the second part witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey, remise release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns the undivided half interest in and to a certain quartz mining claim situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington as recorded in the Auditors Office at Stevenson Skamania Co. Wash. as shown by the recorded mining claims of said William Schulze Mining Claim No. 1, recorded in Book D at page 479 of the records of mines. To gether with all the dips spurs and angles and also all the metals ores gold silver bearing rock and earth therein and all the rights privileged and franchises thereto incident appendant and appurtenant or other wise usually had and enjoyed and rents issues and profits thereof. To have and to hold the said claim all and singular the said premises together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incited unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
