BABCOCK TO LIVINGSTONE.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this twenty first day of August, A.D.1916, by and between  
A.R.Babcock and Lydia A.Babcock, his wife, of the County of Skamania and State of  
Washington, hereinafter called the Mortgagors, and Robert Livingstone, of Portland,  
Oregon, WITNESSETH: That the said Mortgagors, for and in consideration of the sum of  
Fourteen Hundred & No/100 (\$1400.00) Dollars, United States Gold Coin, to them in hand  
paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed  
and by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mortgagee, his heirs  
legal representatives and assigns, those certain premises situate in the County of  
Skamania and State of Washington, and described as follows, to-wit:

The northeast one quarter of the northwest one quarter (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) and the East one  
half of the east one half of the northwest one quarter of the northwest one quarter  
(E 1/2 E 1/2 NW 1/4 NW 1/4) all in Section eight (8) Township one (1) North of Range five (5)  
East of the Willamette Meridian. Except one and twenty hundredths (1.20) acres formerly  
deeded to the Belle Center Congregational Church and Cemetery Association as follows:  
Commencing at a point ten hundred eight (1008) feet west of the north quarter (1/4)  
Government Post of Section eight (8) Township One (1) North of Range five (5) East  
of the Willamette Meridian, running thence south thirty degrees (30deg.) East one hundred  
ninety nine 8/10 (199.8) feet, thence East two hundred fifty two 5/10 (252.5) feet,  
thence north one hundred seventy three (173) feet, thence west three hundred fifty one
