

Know all men by these presents that we, C.O. Williams and Amanda Williams his wife as principals are held and firmly bound unto Earl Marble in the sum of one thousand dollars in gold coin of the United States to be paid to the said Earl Marble his executors administrators or assigns for which payment well and truly to be made we hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seal and dated the 12th day of May 1911

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounded C.O. Williams and Amanda Williams shall on the 12th day of May one thousand nine hundred and fourteen make execute and deliver unto the said Earl Marble (provided the said Earl Marble shall on or before that day have paid to the said C.O. Williams and Amanda Williams the sum of five hundred dollars and have allowed said C.O. Williams his heirs and assigns to remove any timber they may wish to remove from this described tract with the exception of one square acre in the NE corner of said tract, provided further that said Earl Marble shall have build a house & done improvements to the amount of \$300.00 on said tract, the price by said Earl Marble agreed to be paid therefor), a good and sufficient conveyance with the usual covenants, for the following described premises situate and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit: Commencing at the quarter post on the east side of section thirty three (33) Township two (2) North of Range six (6) East of the Willmette Meridian, thence west about 810 feet to the center of a road to be paid out hereafter, thence in a northerly direction about 537.7 feet thence east to section line, thence south to place of commencement containing ten (10) acres, the timber on one acre in the NE corner of this described tract is to go with the land, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
