

Notice of Claim Location

Dear Sir:

I hereby file a lode mining claim with all mineral rights located at SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 10, T9N, R8E in the Gifford Pinchot Natl Forest, Skamania Co, Wash.

The Forestry map shows a defined curve on Road 111, Sec 10, T9N, R8E at this curve there is a large stump on the west side of the road with a surveyor marker nailed to it. The markings on this stump read as follows: P.P., L 752 + 87, C 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ (114) 37 $\frac{3}{4}$ 1:1

T.O.R.F.W. Just south of this stump is a tree with a marker nailed to it that reads: P.P. STA 0+60 DIST 76 $\frac{6}{8}$ BR. S 30° W

My location is due west of this stump over a small knoll and down in the McCoy Creek bed. There is a "Center of Discovery" stake + 4 corner markers - claim 300 ft on each side of center of Creek and 300 ft down stream and 1200 ft upstream lying in a parallelogram -

Under each marker + monument is a can with my name + date + time of discovery.
