MORRISON TO TORNOW

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 4th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eleven Between Frank B. Morrison, a single man, the party of the first part and Albert Tornow party of the second part WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred (\$900.00) Dollars lawful money of the United States, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, Grant, Bargain, sell, Convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described tract, lot or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the county of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: The east one half of that certain tract of land deeded to Frank B. Morrison on December 27, 1910 by John Mitchell and Emma Mitchell, his wife, the land hereby granted being all the land East of a line drawn south from the center of the North line of said tract so granted by said Mitchell and wife, which said granted tract is described as follows: "All that part of the Felix G. Iman donation Land claim situated in the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of section Two (2) Township Two North, Range Seven (7) East of the Willamette Meridian, except that portion thereof heretofore deeded or transferred to J. Graves by bond for deed recorded in Book K, page 94, Deed records of Skamania county, containing twenty-five acres more or less." Together with the appurtenances, to have and to hold the said premises, with the appurtenances, unto said party of the second part, and to his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part, for himself, and for his heirs, executors or administrators does by these presents, covenant and agree to and with the said party
