Royce Vallet to Kribs

The Grantor Myrtle Royse formerly Myrtle Vallett, sole heir of Emma Vallett nee Iman, and her husband Amos J. Royse of Stevenson Washington for and in consideration of three hundred and twenty five dollars and 40/100 dollars in hand paid convey and warrant to Frederick A. Kribs of Portland Oregon the following described real estate situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington An undivided 1/24 of the W½ of the SE¼ and E½ of SW¼ of Section 35 Township 3 North Range 7 East of W.M. and also an undivided 1/24 of an undivided 3/4 of the NE portion of the Daniel Baughman Donation claim more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the bank of the Columbia River at the SE corner of the donation land claim of Daniel Baughman thence running north about 9 chains to the NE corner of said claim; thence running east on the north line of said claim about 76 chains to the north west corner of said claim, thence running south about 9.09 chains along the west line of said claim, thence running in a straight line to a post on the bank of the Columbia River heretofore marked D.B. & F.G.I., thence up the Columbia River on the meander line to the place of beginning, containing 167½ acres more or less, saving and excepting therefrom what is known as the Rock Creek Island which was conveyed by Felix Iman and Margaret Iman to Monroe Vallett by deed which was duly recorded in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County Washington Nov. 1st 1891 in Book C of deeds at page 361 and also saving and excepting that portion of said Daniel Baughman D.L.C. included in deed made by Felix G.
