Cameron his heirs and assigns forever a right of way across the following described real estate situate lying and being in the counties of gkamania and Klickitat in the state of Washington to-wit:

The Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of section ten (10) in Township three(3) North of Range ten (10) wast of the Willamette Meridian said right of way as now laid out used by said R.D. Cameron being for the purpose of maintaining that certain pipe line as now laid and used by said R.D. Cameron, granting unto said R.D. Cameron his heirs and assgns the right to enter upon the above described property for the purpose of keeping said pipe line in repair.
