Lot numbered seven (7) and the east one half of Lot numbered six (6) in Block numbered six (6) of Johnson's addition to the town of Stevenson, according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the recorder of Skamania county Washington, excepting therefrom a strip of land six feet in width along the south side thereof heretofore deeded to the town of Stevenson for street and also excepting a strip of land four (4) feet in width along the north side thereof heretofore granted to Louis Aalvik and Hektor Aalvik for a right of way.
