

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That George W. Whiteside and Adeline C. Hamlin of County of Skamania State of Washington have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Hugh W. Hamlin his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington: Undivided one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the following described parcel of land situated in the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section nineteen (19), township three (3) north, range ten (10) east of the Willamette Meridian to-wit:-
