This Indenture made this 23rd day of December 1910 between John Malcom Campbell of Vallejo in the State of California one of the United States of America and Celia D. Campbell his wife (hereinafter called the Vendors) of the one part, and Wilbert M. Campbell of the city of Seattle in the State of Washington one of the United States of America, Vice president of the Whiton Hardware Company of Seattle (hereinafter called the Purchaser) of the other part; Whereas Thomas Brotherton, late of Underwood, Skamania County Washington, died intestate and seized of the lands and hereditaments hereinafter set forth: And whereas the Vendors as one of the heirs of the said Thomas Brotherton is entitled to a one ninth share or interest in his estate and has agreed to sell to the purchaser all their said one ninth interest or share in the said hereditaments for the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00):

Now therefor this Indenture Witnesseth that in pursuance of the said agreement and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars money of the United States of America to them in hand paid by the purchaser, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the Vendors do by these presents grant, bargain, sell convey and confirm unto the said purchaser his heirs and assigns all that one undivided one ninth share or interest of them the Vendors of and in that piece or parcel of land lying and being in Skamania County Washington and more particularly known and described as the south half of the Northeast quarter and the south half of the Northwest quarter of Section five (5) Township three (3) North of Range ten (10) E.W.M., together with the appurtenances. To have and to hold the said undivided one ninth share or interest in the said premises with the appurtenances unto the Purchaser his heirs and assigns forever. And they the vendors their heirs executors and administrators do by these presents covenant and agree to and with the purchaser his heirs and assigns that they the Vendors all and singular the said undivided one ninth interest in said premises and appurtenances unto the purchaser his heirs and assigns and against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by through or under the Vendors shall and will warrant and forever defend.
