

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a vein or lode of mineral bearing rock in place upon the unappropriated public domain of the United States within the State of Oregon and said Mining District; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States, of the State of Oregon and the regulations of said Mining District, have located and do hereby locate a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post at the point of discovery, marked Post No. 1. The name of the claim is **CHARBONNEAU MINES #1** Claim, further described as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1 (Discovery Post), from thence

50' feet in a NORTH

direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence

300' feet in a WEST

direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence

1,500' feet in a SOUTH

direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence

300' feet in a EAST

direction to an end post marked No. 5, thence

300' feet in a EAST

direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence

1,500' feet in a NORTH

direction to a corner post marked No. 7, thence

300' feet in a WEST

direction to said end post marked No. 2,

The locators claim 50'

feet in a NORTH

direction from point of discovery to the SOUTH

end line and 1,450'

feet in the opposite direction from point of discovery to the

SOUTH end line and

300' feet on each side of the middle of said vein or lode, further claiming all the surface rights,

privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as being 158' E As Feet from a natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity, to-wit: LITTLE CREEK

(use township and range, if possible)

25' NORTH OF EAST FORK O.F. THE LEWIS RIVER
