I, H.H. Olmstead, being first duly sworn do depose and say: That I have personal knowledge of the fact that Charles F. Wetherell who received patent for Lots eleven and twelve in Section thirty-six, township four north of range seven and one-half east of the Willamette Meridian, was a single man at the time he made his homestead entry on said land and at the time he received patent, which patent bears date February 13, 1905, and appears of record in Book "E" at page 137 of the deed records of Skamania County, Washington; ^{that} and C.E. Wetherell who acquired title to said land from said Charles F. Wetherell by deed dated April 15, 1905, recorded Book "I" at page 409 of the deed records of said Skamania County, Washington, was then a widower with one son about 3 yrs old, and that J.T. Reynolds who acquired title from said C.E.
