PRESTON STEVENSON ET-UX ET-AL.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Louisa B. Preston (a spinster) having received the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollars as a partial payment on that certain mortgage executed by Miles B. Stevenson and Blanche Stevenson, his wife, and John W. Stevenson mortgagors dated July 19th, 1916, in favor of Louisa B. Preston mortgagee and recorded in book "N" of record of mortgages for the County of Skamania State of Washington on page 268 on the 25th day of July 1910, does hereby release from the lien of said mortgage the following described premises therein described, viz:

Commencing at a point 814.3 feet South of the Section corners of sections 9, 10, 15, and 16, Township 1 North Range 5, East of the Willamette Meridian, this point being the meander corner between sections 15 and 16, said Township and Range, thence South 45 degrees West 257 feet; thence South 15 degrees, 44' East 100.8 feet to the South line of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Right of Way, being the point of beginning of the tract herein described; thence South 65 degrees, 37' West along the South line of said Right of Way, 440 feet to a point which is the Northwest corner of the tract herein described; thence South 20 degrees, 15' East about 150 feet to the approximate low water line of the Columbia River; thence Easterly along the low water meander line of said Columbia River to a point South, 15 degrees, 44' East, about 90 feet from the point of beginning, thence North 15 degrees, 44' West to the point of beginning, containing 1.12 acres, more or less, and that the remainder of said lands in said mortgage specified shall remain subject thereto as heretofore.
