VALLETT --- ATTWELL.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 4th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Seventeen. BETWEEN Menree Vallett, a single man, party of the first part, and Myrtle Attwell party of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Sixty five and no/100 Dollars lawful money of the United States, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Warrant unto the said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns, the following described tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point 31.47 chs. East of the SW corner of the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the H. Shepard D.L.C. said corner being situated 15.75 chains East and 20.97 chains North of the Quarter Section corner to Section 1 and 36, Twp. 2 and 3 North Range 7 East; thence North 17° 07' West 24.52 chs. to Northwest corner; thence East 21.33 chs. to Northeast corner; thence South 17° 07' East 24.52 chs. to Southeast corner; thence West 21.33 chs. to Southwest corner or place of beginning, containing 50 acres, save and excepting out of above described tract of land, to-wit:
