Notice is hereby given that the undersigned does claim a tunnel site known as Firlock III. This claim shall begin at corner post # 3 of the Firlock Lode claim thence 3000 feet upstream Boulder Creek in a Northerly direction including all veins uncovered within said 3000 ft. length and a length of 1500 feet for each vein.

This notice has been placed at corner post # 3 of the Firlock lode claim (A 14 inch white Fir tree 50 feet west of Boulder Creek). Another post has been placed 3000 feet upstream Boulder Creek to indicate the Northern limit of the claim.

The claim is further described as follows: On National Forest land (Gifford Pinchot Natl. Forest). In Boulder Creek, Tributary of the Lewis River, approximately one mile up stream from Forest Service road N 90, State of Washington, Skamania county. The land is unsurveyed but land description projections indicate Section 23, Township 9N, Range 9 E, W.M.
