But it is further provided and agreed by and between the parties hereto that the said parties of the first part will procure and ~~agree to~~ maintain, and deliver to the party of the second part, policies of insurance against loss by fire upon the buildings situated upon said premises, issued by a company selected by the party of the second part, to the amount of Five Hundred Dollars, until said indebtedness is fully paid, and will cause a clause to be written in such policy directing the loss thereunder to be paid to the party of the second part, as her interest may appear.
