Swank his wife of lawful age, in consideration of one dollar to us paid by the Chee Lumber Co. a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Washington, principal office Vancouver, Washington, do hereby remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said The Chee Lumber Company and unto its successors and assigns all our right, title and interest in and to all that parcel of real estate situate in County of Skamania, State of Washington to-wit:
