THIS INDENTURE, Made this 24th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Nine hundred and seventeen BETWEEN F.H. Graves <sup>and wife</sup> Party of the first part, and E.J. Wigal party of the second part: WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged is hereby does by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Warrant unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows to-wit:

South ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) one half of lot (5) five, in Section (36) Thirty six, Township Four, North of Range ( $7\frac{1}{4}$ ) seven and one half, East of Willamette Meridian being a tract of land containing 20 acres more or less according to Government survey, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.
