having complied with the requirements of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and with all the local laws, customs and regulations, has this 9th day of MAY, 1980, located a claim and by these presents do locate a claim by right of discovery and location, 1500 linear feet horizontal measurement on and along lode, vein, ledge or deposit, along the vein thereof, with all dips, angles and variations as allowed by law, together with 300 feet on the N side and 300 feet on the S side of the middle of said vein at the surface so far as can be determined from present developments, and all veins, lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground within the lines of said claim, 1450 linear feet, running W from this discovery post and 50 feet running E from this discovery post, said discovery post being situated upon said lode, vein or deposit and within the lines of said claim in M'Coy CREEK mining district, SKAMANIA County, State of Washington, which claim is more particularly described as follows:





This notice should be posted at each center end and each corner of the claim and a copy be retained.

Locate claim accurately with reference to some natural object or permanent monument, and record according to government survey, and mark the boundaries on the ground as they are located and recorded.

Loc. locations may include fifteen hundred feet on the course of the ledge, together with three hundred feet on either side of the middle of the vein.

Witnesses are not necessary, but advisable. Fill out all blanks with ink or indelible pencil.
