Useful work and improvements in the amount of more than \$24,000.00 were done and made during the period from September 1, 1979 to August 31, 1980 by John Cook, Inc., 3807 East 11th Avenue, Spokane, Washington 99202 at the request of Denison Mines (U.S.) Incorporated, whose address is N. 9107 Country Homes Boulevard, Suite 4, Spokane, Washington 99218 for all of the lode mining claims listed in attached "Exhibit A", located in the Copper Creek mining district, Skamania County, Washington, T. 3 N., R. 5 E., W.M., in Sections 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 10; T. 4 N., R. 5 E., W.M., in Sections 27, 28, 29, 32, 33 and 34.

A total of 244 contiguous mining claims are included in this statement. Work and improvements required more than 30 man-days of labor, consisting of more than 2,990 feet of core drilling completed in four holes as follows:
