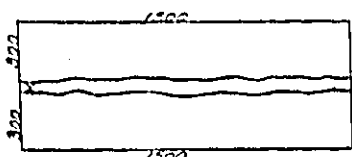
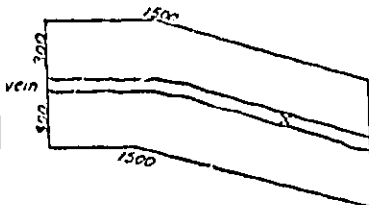


Notice of Mining Location

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District, haS located and do NOW hereby locate 1320 linear feet in length, and 660 feet in width on the PINE FLATS lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in the above State, County and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence 900 feet in a N. Westerly direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence 330 feet in a N. Westerly direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence 1320 feet in a S. Easterly direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence 330 feet in a N. Easterly direction to a corner post marked No. 5, thence 330 feet in a N. Easterly direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence 1320 feet in a N. Westerly direction to said end post No. 2; No. 7, 330 feet in a S. Westerly direction to claim 900 feet in a N. Westerly direction from discovery to the 330 S. Westerly end line, and 330 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the EAST end line and 330 feet on each side of the middle of said lode or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all surface rights, privileges, and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.
