THIS INDENTURE, Made this Fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Eighteen BETWEEN Christ Fletch and Burga Fletch his wife Parties of the first part, and J.W. Page and Alice L. Page his Wife parties of the second part: WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do and by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Warrant unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, the following described tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point Thirty ft. .30ft. East and 1020 ft., One Thousand and Twenty ft., North of the South West Corner of the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty One (21) Township No. Three (3) North of Range Eight (8) East of Willamette Meridian running thence East Forty rods (40) Thence South Twenty Rods (20) Thence West Forty Rods (40) Thence North Twenty Rods (20) to the point of beginning Containing Five Acres (5) And also a strip of land Thirty ft.
