## Calderwood to Northwestern Electric Company. ✓

In consideration of Twenty five Dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Bixby J. Calderwood, a bachelor grants to Northwestern Electric Company a perpetual right-of-way in and over the following described real property, situated in County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit: That part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, T.3 N.R.8 East of W.M. which is described in a deed to grantor recorded in Book H, page 463, Records of said County and State. Also this grant is intended to include said right of way over the land of Mary A. Calderwood lying east of and along the survey of pole line which I may hereafter acquire by inheritance from my father David E.
