First parties agree to keep house insured in sum of \$600.00.

And it is further stipulated and agreed between the parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators or assigns that in case of the foreclosure of this mortgage at any sale had thereunder, the purchaser thereof shall be entitled to the immediate possession of the premises so sold whether or not the same are then occupied as a homestead.
