

Lazenby to Knapp

This Indenture Witnesseth that C.D.Lazenby and Rena Lazenby his wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred thirty dollars (\$1530.) in lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by Margaret Knapp, party of the second part, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington, to-wit:

An undivided three eights ($\frac{3}{8}$) of the south east quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of section number seventeen (17) in Township three (3) North of Range ten (10) East of Willamette Meridian, and comprising fifteen acres (15). To have and to hold the said premises with all their appurtenances unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns forever; and the said parties of the first part for themselves and for their heirs executors and administrators do hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns that they are the owners in fee simple of said premises and that they are free from all incumbrances except a mortgage for two thousand (\$2000) dollars given to E.H.Hartwig July 16th 1910, and that they will warrant and defend the title thereto against all lawful claims whatsoever.
