INDEPENDENT LOGGING CO. INC. TO PORTLAND HARDWOOD FLOOR CO. INC.

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That Independent Logging Co., Inc. a Corporation incorporated organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon, with its principal office at Portland, Oregon, party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four thousand and no/100 Dollars to it paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents does bargain sell and convey unto Portland Hardwood Floor Co. Inc., party of the second part, all of the following described real estate, situate and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington to-wit:-

The Southeast quarter of Section Five in Township three North of Range Eight East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, Washington, containing 160 acres, together with tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same with the appurtenances unto the said Portland Hardwood Floor Co. Inc., and assigns forever.

This Conveyance is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four Thousand and No/100 Dollars, in accordance with the tenor of a certain instrument of writing of which the following substantial copy to-wit:-

\$4000.00 (Copy) Feb. 8th, 1918.

Eight months after date, for value received, Independent Logging Co. Inc. a Corporation, promise to pay to the order of Portland Hardwood Floor Co. Inc., Four Thousand and no/100 Dollars, for value received, with interest from date, payable quarterly at the rate of eight per cent per annum, until paid, principal and interest payable in U.S. Gold Coin, at Portland, Oregon, at Northwestern National Bank and in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof, the said Corporation promises to pay such additional sum of money as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees in said suit or action. Said Corporation further agrees to pay any reasonable sum as attorney's fees, that the holder of this note incurs in the collection of same or any portion thereof, even if no suit or action is instituted thereon.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the President and Secretary of said Corporation, under authority of a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors, have hereunto signed the name of the Corporation and affixed its corporate seal.
