all in Township Three (3) North, Range Nine (9) East of Willamette Meridian, in the County of Skamania, State of Washington; together with the right to cut all trees and brush standing or growing within one hundred fifty (150) feet of either of said transmission lines necessary to be cut in the construction, operation and protection of said transmission lines from danger. This grant is made subject to the following express conditions:

That said transmission lines shall cross the said premises in an Easterly and Westerly direction; that the first or South transmission line shall be abeated at not posit more than three hundred (300) feet North from the South line of said lots and that the second transmission line, when constructed, shall at no point be more than fifty (50) feet from the center line of the poles of the said first transmission line. In constructing the said transmission lines the party of the second part may at its option use wooden poles or steel towers, there to be not to exceed eight (8) poles or towers on each transmission line, making sixteen (16) poles or towers in all. The se ond party shall at all times maintain its said transmission lines constructed under authority hereof in safe condition and in compliance with all lawful requirements and so as not to interfere with the use of said premises by the party of the first part, its successors or assigns, for all purposes not inconsistent with this grant.

Should the party of the second part, its successors or assigns, at any time abandon the said transmission line or lines constructed upon the said premises, or fail to observe the conditions of this grant, then and in that event this easement shall immediately terminate and the party of the second part, its successors or assigns, shall forthwith remove all of its property constructed woon said premises therefrom.
